

All dogs and cats four months and older must be vaccinated. Our goal is to provide residents with a low cost clinic to prevent the occurrence of any rabid animals in your community.

Rabies is a real threat to you and your family. If you are infected with rabies and you don't get treated, you could die. Getting your animal vaccinated is the best insurance you can have against this deadly disease. Please bring your animals and attend one of these clinics. We are here to aid the wellbeing of your family and your pet.

When you come, **please leave all animals in the vehicle (regardless of carriers or restraint)**. If you do not have a cage, please bring someone with you to sit with your animals while you fill out appropriate paperwork. This is to prevent the animals from getting scared, running away, and fighting. **The Veterinarian will come to your vehicle when it's your turn.**
