Water Outages Planned in Pamlico County HWY 304 Residents Will Experience Low Water Pressure or Possible Water Outages during Water Main Relocation

Pamlico County, NC -Customers along sections of Highway 304 between the communities of Vandemere and Lowland and surrounding areas will experience low water pressure or water outages on the following dates:

Monday, November 9, 2009, beginning at 9:00 a.m.
Thursday, November 12, 2009 beginning at 9:00 a.m.
Monday, November 16, 2009, beginning at 9:00 a.m.

Note: This schedule is subject to change due to weather and unforeseen conditions.

The outage is expected to last at least 8 hours with previous outages lasting 8 to 24 hours.

The Pamlico County Water Department will be shutting down a portion of the water transmission line serving residents along Highway 304 due to relocating water lines for a DOT bridge replacement project.

You may want to take precautions to have water available for toilet flushing or other essential uses by filling your bathtub or other containers with water before the shutdown period. Also, you may want to have bottled water available.
