### **One-Stop Voting**

Begins on October 16, 2008 and ends on November 1, 2008 at 1:00pm

One-stop voting sites will be: Pamlico County Courthouse  
Grantsboro Town Hall

Both locations will be open for voting: Monday – Friday 8:00am – 6:00pm  
Saturdays 8:00am – 1:00pm

Registered voters of Pamlico County may vote at either One-stop location.

**\* Residents of Pamlico County may register and vote at either One-stop location. Identification must be shown while registering that states the residents' current address. Registering at a One-stop location does not make the voter eligible to vote on Election Day, they must vote while at the One-stop location.**

The Official Canvass will be held on November 14, 2008 at 11:00am at the Pamlico County Courthouse. The Canvass is open to the public.
