The Environmental Health Division maintains and improves the community environmental conditions. For more information, call 745-5634.

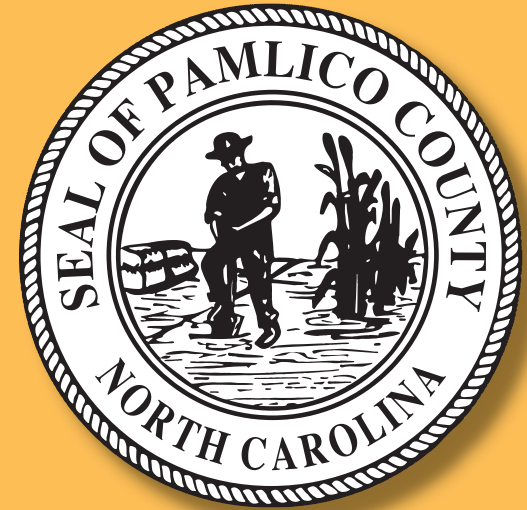

W.I.C.

Women, Infants and Children (WIC) is also called the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program. WIC is a federal program designed to provide food to low-income pregnant, postpartum and breast-feeding women, infants and children until the age of 5.

The program provides a combination of nutrition education, supplemental foods, breast-feeding promotion and support, and referrals for health care.
