**HURRICANE FLORENCE  
NOTICE #2**

**Pamlico County Evacuation/Sheltering Instructions**

Due to the potential impact of Hurricane Florence, Pamlico County issued a Mandatory Evacuation Notice to be effective September 11, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. Pamlico County has enacted its agreement with NC Emergency Management and Inland Host County (Wake) to provide Safe Sheltering out of the direct storm path. Please adhere to the following:

- **Registration at Pamlico Community College beginning at 3:00 pm on Tuesday September 11, 2018. Please bring photo identification, sleeping materials, personal hygiene items, medications, and clothes.**
- **If you can drive and wish to go to an Inland Shelter, once registered, we will provide travel instructions for you to proceed on your own.**
- **If you do not have transportation, you can leave your vehicle at Pamlico Community College and we will provide transportation to our Inland shelter via buses.**
- If you do not need County or Inland Shelter, we are encouraging you to stay with family or friends out of the storm's path.
- Inland host shelter is for citizens only. No animals allowed.

**Pamlico County Shelter**

- Located at Pamlico Community College 5049 NC Hwy 306 S. will open on Wednesday September 12, 2018 at 5:00 pm.
- We are again encouraging folks who can and are willing to travel inland to do so to prevent our local shelter from being over capacity.
- County Shelter is Animal Friendly. Please see document on Page 2 regarding requirements for Animal Sheltering.
- Please bring your own sleeping materials, personal hygiene items, and small personal items. We will have some Cots available. Please be prepared to stay until the storm event is over.

## **Pet Friendly Shelter Requirements:**

The owner must be registered at the shelter for a pet to stay. The pet owner will need to bring the following:

- Current rabies vaccination records for all pets
- Crate or container large enough for pet(s)
- Bedding for your pet(s)
- Bowls for your pet(s)
- Food for your pet(s)
- Meds for your pet(s)
- Leashes for your pet(s)

Be prepared to stay for several days to over a week. During the time that you are there with your animals, there will be staff in the shelter. The owner of the animal will be responsible for the following:

- Following the rules of the animal shelter and its staff
- Caring for your animals
- Walking the dogs
- Cleanup of the crate that your animal is in
- Cats and ferrets are NOT allowed out of their crates. Other pets will be allowed out of crates at the discretion of the shelter staff.

When the shelter is shut down any animal that is still at the shelter will be taken to the Craven Animal Shelter located on Old Airport Rd in James City.

When you get to the shelter, leave your pet in your car until you are registered. After you complete registration, you will be directed to the animal shelter where you will register your animal. You must stay at the shelter while your pet is in the animal shelter. Any animal without an owner will be considered abandoned and be taken to the Craven Animal Shelter and charges may be filed against the owner.
