Water Outage and Low Pressure Advisory

The water consumers of Pamlico County Water System are experiencing periods of low pressure and outages in the distribution system due to a ruptured water main. Water department staff members and/or contractors are currently working on the repairs to the line. Once service is restored, the following areas are covered under this advisory:

- Don Lee Road from the intersection of Kershaw Road to the intersection of Buckland Road
- Highway 306 South from the intersection of Kershaw to the end by the ferry
- Buckland Rd
- Janiero Road
- Kennels Beach Road
- Howell Road
- Seafarer Road
- Neuse Road from Scott Town Road to Seafarer Road
- Any adjacent roads off the aforementioned roads.

Periods of low or no pressure in the distribution system increases the potential for back siphonage and introduction of bacteria into the water system.

Therefore, the Pamlico County Water Department advises that when water is restored consumers **boil all water** used for human consumption (including drinking, cooking, brushing teeth, making ice and washing hands) or use bottled water.

Vigorous boiling for one (1) minute should kill any disease-causing organisms that may be present in the water.

This office is strongly urging the water consumers to conserve water whenever possible. This advisory remains in effect until water samples meet requirements and further written notification is issued.
