Pamlico County Reports First Death Related to COVID-19

The Pamlico County Health Department is reporting the first COVID-19 associated death in Pamlico County.

The individual died on June 29th. The patient was elderly and had significant underlying medical conditions for which they had been hospitalized. To protect the family's privacy, no further information about this patient will be released.

Scott Lenhart, Pamlico County Health Director reminds everyone to practice the 3 "W"s, Wear, Wait and Wash. Practicing the 3 "W"s is a very good way to help reduce the spread of COVID 19. If you must leave home, practice your 3 Ws:

- **Wear** a cloth covering over your nose and mouth.
- **Wait** 6 feet apart. Avoid close contact.
- **Wash** your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer.

These actions can protect our families and neighbors as the state works to ease restrictions while the virus is still circulating.
