Pamlico County COVID-19

Case Updates

May 7th, 2020 19:30 Hours

Of the two (2) current active positive COVID-19 Cases in Pamlico County, both cases have been deemed by Public Health officials as **recovered** and are off required isolation measures. The necessary isolation requirements are being free of COVID-19 symptoms and fever without fever reducing medications for a minimum of 72 consecutive hours.

Case #7 identified on 24-April-2020 was cleared by Health Officials at 1500 hours today's date and was included in the case count on the Community Report released earlier today.

Case #8 identified on 1-May-2020 was cleared by Health Officials at 18:00 hours today's date.

Pamlico County at this time has **ZERO (0)** new Positive cases and Eight (8) cases listed as **recovered**.

We encourage all citizens not only locally but state and nationwide to assist with flattening the COVID-19 positive curve by practicing social distancing, personal hygiene, virtual means and methods of communications, and continue to follow recommendations and guidelines from Official Local, State and National Sources.
