Pamlico County Government Offices Will Close to Public

Due to continued threat of Coronavirus (COVID-19), all Pamlico County Government offices will close to the public except by appointment effective Monday, March 30, 2020 at noon (12:00 p.m.) and will remain closed until April 30, 2020. County officials will evaluate conditions continually and revisit the issue if necessary. While Pamlico County Government offices will close to the public, Pamlico County employees will continue to work to ensure the continuity of the essential services Pamlico County provides for citizens. Pamlico County employee health and safety as well as that of our citizens is paramount and departments are working to ensure work is designed to allow for appropriate social distancing.

Due to Governor Executive Order 121, the Alliance Park is closed until further notice to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Other County outdoor parks will remain open.

Regarding Pamlico County Water Department, disconnects for nonpayment, penalties and interest are suspended until April 30, 2020.

Pamlico County Government is offering alternative methods for the public to obtain services in order to encourage social distancing in County offices in compliance with North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper’s mandate regarding mass gatherings and other critical guidance provided by federal and state partners.
