

# **PAMLICO COUNTY WATER DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCEMENT**

Date: SEPTEMBER 18, 2018

Potable water served by the Pamlico County Water System (PWS ID #04-69-025) has been restored to near capacity. Samples collected from multiple locations within the system have been analyzed in a State Certified Laboratory and found to be free of coliform bacteria.

Based on these results, the continued presence of adequate disinfectant residuals, and the maintenance of consistent pressure throughout the system, the **LOW PRESSURE ADVISORY** issued for **SEPTEMBER 14, 2018** is **RESCINDED**, effective immediately.

**This notice also rescinds the Water Conservation Notice, effective immediately.**

The area affected includes: Intersection of HWY 307 and HWY 304 including all of HWY 307 and HWY 304 and the Towns of Vandemere, Mesic, Hobucken, and Lowland including all adjoining roads from the main arteries.

Residents, businesses and industries served by this system are urged to continue to manage their water usage and consumption and report any leaks or problems to the Pamlico County Water System.
